
Education and Literacy


There are more school-age children out of school in Pakistan than anywhere else in the world with the exception of countries in active conflict. Thanks to HDF donors, our VDOs help to educate parents on the importance of school for their children - especially for girls.

KPI: 2.A.1: Net Primary Enrollment Rate









Health Care

HDF's Healthcare Program focuses on providing preventative measures and educating the population on general health. Health Screening and Seminars have been held in villages to improve general health behaviors for families. These health seminars empower women to live healthier lives and teach their families the importance of diet, cleanliness and reproductive health.

- **8** Community Health Clinics
- Over **21,000** Households served
- **59** Clinic Healthcare Workers
- **134** Mobile Health Camps and 15,000 patients
- **36** Screening Camps
- **3,954** students screened under School Health Programs
- **99%** of women and children in HDF areas have been immunized

Social Capital Development

Thanks to donors like you, all 292 HDF Villages have Village Development Organizations (VDOs).

These VDOs are led by men and women of each community to address village needs.

VDOs have become institutions in the community, and are the first stop for many who need help.

VDOs lead our HDF villages and train members in Community and Disaster Risk Management, Advocacy and Human Rights, and Gender Mainstreaming. In addition to these trainings, VDOs support the work of HDF programs by holding education enrollment outreach events, global hygiene days, and meetings with local government officials. Children Forums have been built in many villages to support the efforts of VDOs.



Sustainable Environment

HDF has partnered with VDOs to complete hundreds of physical infrastructure projects. Our solar powered water filtration plants provide clean drinking water to communities and have a lower impact on our environment. Delay action dams, hand pumps and tube wells, road linkages, and solid waste disposal systems are only a few examples of how donors have supported the building of green communities.


