Waste Management leaf vacuuming underway. The company handled a document destruction day — with approx 100 residents and 2 Township employees attending.

Also taking place at the Township Hall:

An Estate Planning meeting – with approx. 25 residents attending and Voter registration – with approx. 8 or 9 people attending. Nov 7-8th was the last weekend for Boy Scouts camping.

Assessor Jagla

Books were closed for assessments with the County on Nov 2nd. Appeals must be postmarked by Dec. 2nd. Lots of calls to appeal assessments.

Road Commissioner Lesperance

The 3-man tree crew is now done for the season. Paving is also completed for the season.

As of Nov. - out of asphalt funds for the year.

All the plows were re-build with new frames (approx. \$1,000 - \$4,000 per plow)

MFT (Motor Vehicle Fund Tax) has been shut off – Rd Dist out \$12,000 per month. This funding was used for salt purchases. By December, this should be starting up again.

Road District currently has 2,000 tons of salt on hand ready for the winter.

The mulch pile has been moved to Anita Sherwood Park for resident pick-up.

<u>Township Clerk Koscavage</u> – Waste Management missed trash pick up for all of Walking Ridge in C.L. on Oct 19th. Residents were upset about the lack of customer service concern.

Supervisor Jennings requested that any such issues be brought to his attention immediately so that he could have them resolved.

<u>Trustee Palmer</u> – Attended T.O.I. Conference (Township Officials of IL.) in Springfield, IL., with Supervisor Jennings. T.O.I. reported 67% of all local government computers have gotten hacked – T.O.I. suggested having a plan in the event this were to happen.

<u>Trustee Dvorak</u> - Thanked Supervisor Jennings for a good Levy.
